

ORDINANCE NO. 12-20-2006

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING GARBAGE AND TRASH COLLECTION IN THE CITY BY CONTRACTING WITH A PRIVATE ENTITY PROVIDING SUCH SERVICES FOR A FEE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PALMHURST, TEXAS:

The City of Palmhurst, having been advised that a private company that has for many years collected garbage and trash for numerous residents will discontinue service, and the Board of Alderman wishing to provide garbage and trash collection as a governmental service to its residents for a user fee, and the City Manager having negotiated a proposed contract with Allied Waste Services of Rio Grande Valley, and the City Manager also having negotiated a proposed contract with Sharyland Water Supply Corporation to handle the billing and collection of the user fees, and the City being advised by its City Attorney that such contracts can be entered into without competitive bidding,

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordained as follows:

The City of Palmhurst establishes the user fees for the collection of garbage and trash in the City as set forth in an agreement with Allied Waste Services of Rio Grande Valley.

The Mayor of the City is authorized to sign on behalf of the City the contract with Allied Waste Services of Rio Grande Valley which follows and is incorporated into this ordinance.

The Mayor of the City is also authorized to sign shall enter into a contract with Sharyland Water Supply Corporation for billing and collection of the user fees established in connection with garbage and trash collection as provided in this ordinance.
