DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Palmhurst on the 20th day of June, 2024, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from

- Strong to Severe Storms including Tornadoes, Flooding and damaging winds from Tropical Storm Alberto

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Palmhurst has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PALMHURST;

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for The City of Palmhurst pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Palmhurst.

Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City of Palmhurst emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
